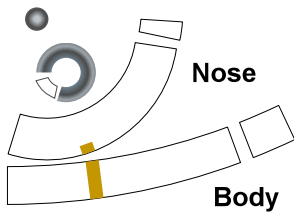
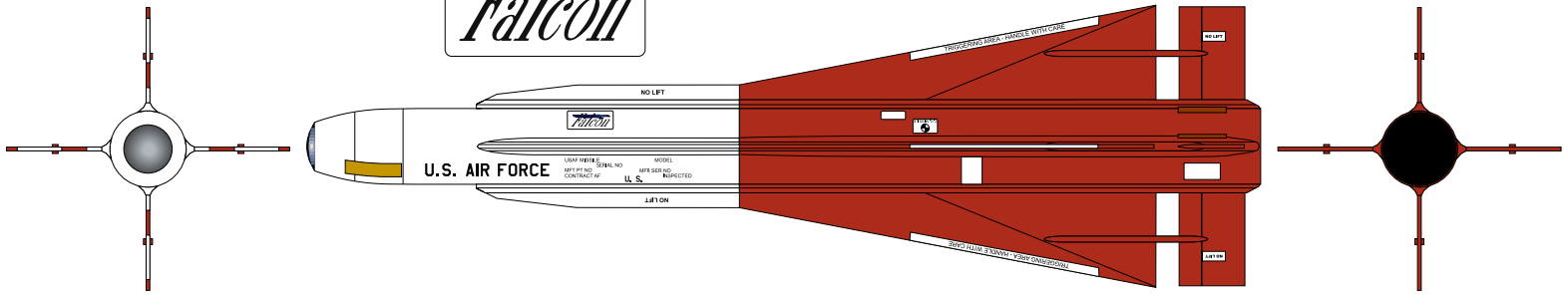


# HUGHES AIM-4G FALCON

The AIM-4G was built by Hughes Aircraft and saw service with the USAF and Air National Guard organizations. About 3400 IR Super Falcons were built, replacing most earlier versions of the weapon in service. The AIM-4G was used primarily on F-102 Delta Dagger and F-106 Delta Dart and was retired from service in 1988.



Note: Use jig to align inner nozzle and disk. Also use jig to align nozzle and support to missile body.

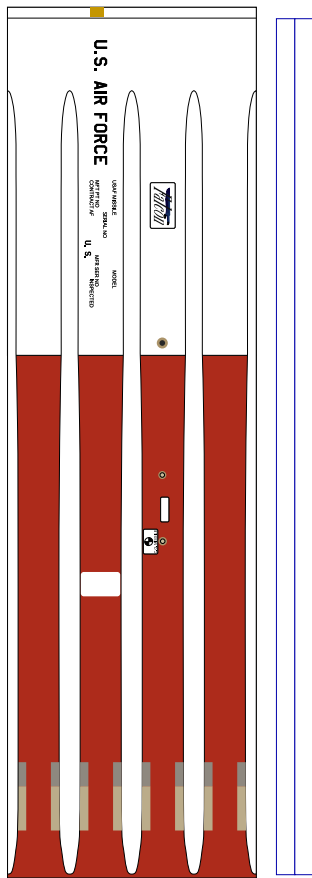
Alignment Tube

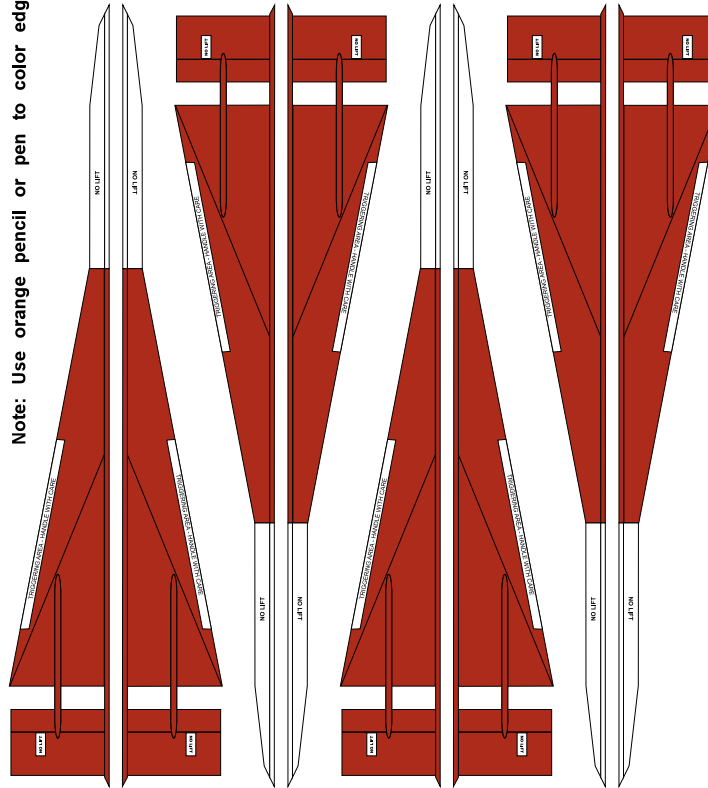
Fold and Glue

Note: Glue jig parts together but do not glue jig to model.

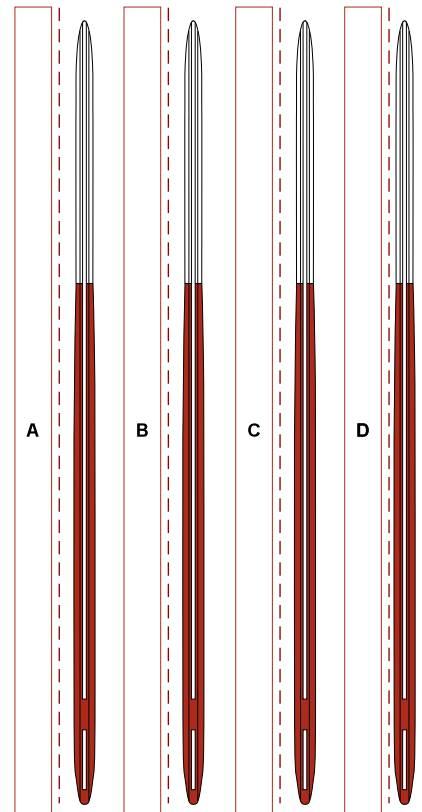
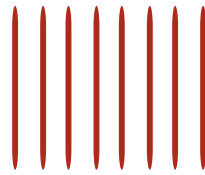


Note: Use orange pencil or pen to color edges.

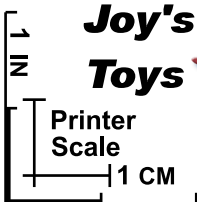
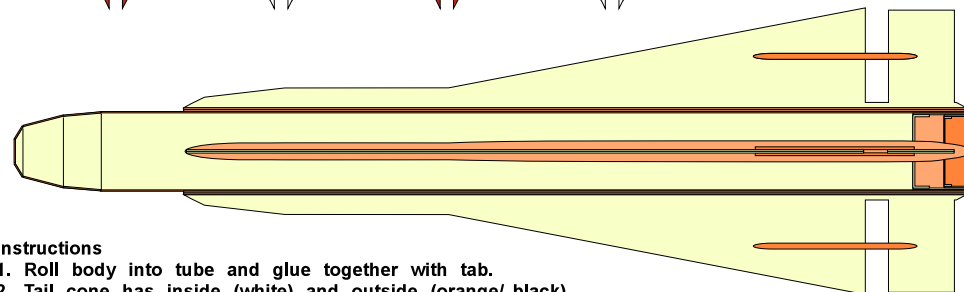
Wings

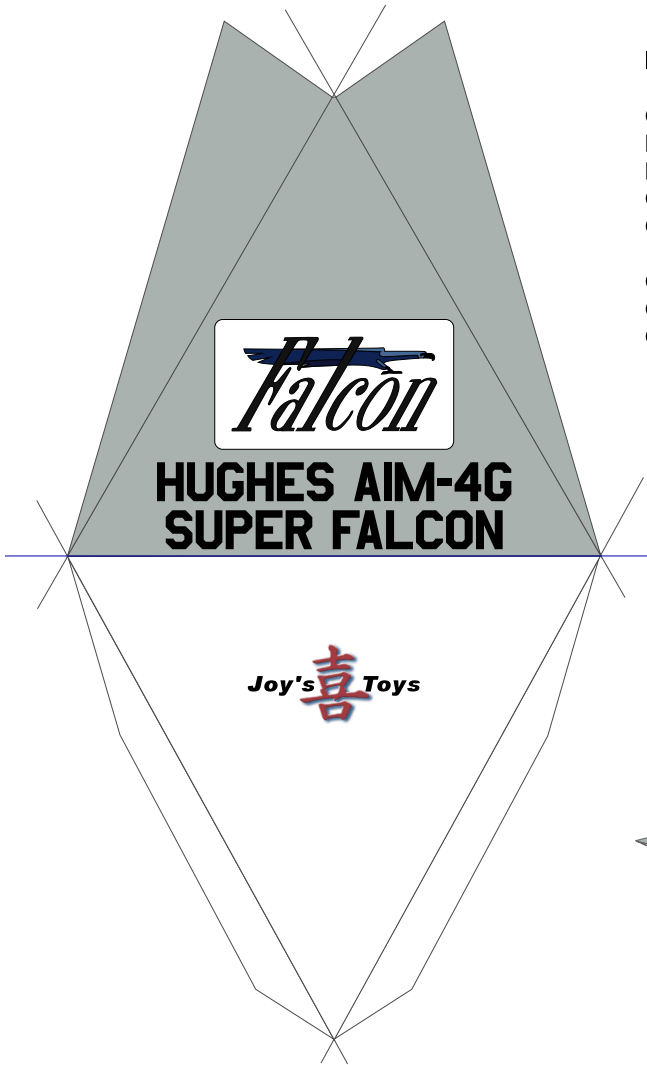
## Instructions

1. Roll body into tube and glue together with tab.
2. Tail cone has inside (white) and outside (orange/ black)
3. Using jig, align tail cone sections and glue together with body.
4. Glue nose sections together and to body.
5. Fold wing root halves together and while damp, form lengthwise around a straw. Dry and cut out. Align by letters and glue to body.
6. Cut out wing doubles and glue together. Glue tail fin supports to each side of wings. Cut out each wing carefully using a hobby knife, leaving tail fins attached. Glue to body.
7. Assemble stand and attach to missile.

### Instructions for Stand

Cut out 5 parts for base and support  
Fold sides and glue tabs on main base, no glue.  
Fold bottom under base, no glue.  
Glue 2 inner support stand sides together (white).  
Glue 2 outer support stand sides together (gray),  
keeping glue tabs separated on the bottom.  
Glue support stand tabs to inside base sides.  
Glue side tabs to stand bottom.  
Glue missile to stand.
